NPC 19-910 For violation of the Data Privacy Act of 2012

RESOLUTION

On 05 November 2020, the Commission issued an Order granting the request by Respondent Fynamics Lending, Inc. (Respondent) for a thirty (30) day extension or until 15 November 2020 to submit the documents requested following the Clarificatory Hearing held on 01 October 2020.

On 15 November 2020, Respondent filed a Motion for Additional Time to File Compliance, requesting for another extension of ten (10) days within which to comply with the 01 October 2020 Order of the Commission. They state in their Motion:

3. The Respondent respectfully manifest (sic) that while it endeavored to secure the required documents, it was experiencing difficulty due to the resignation and layoffs of its former employees. Moreover, its efforts were hampered by the series of typhoons which affected Metro Manila.

Considering the circumstances raised by Respondent and in the interest of an exhaustive investigation, the Commission grants the requested additional time to submit the required documents.

WHEREFORE, the Commission GRANTS a final and non-extendible extension of ten (10) days or until 25 November 2020 for Fynamics Lending, Inc. to produce and submit the documents specified in the Order dated 01 October 2020.

Failure to comply with this Order shall cause the Commission to adjudicate the issues on the basis of the evidence on record.
